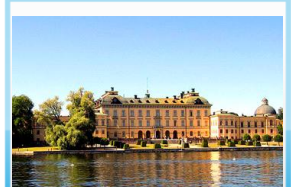

Visit the Porvoo Museum There are 220,000 items in the museum collection, from archaeological finds to luxury objects and industrial arts. It includes over 300 pieces from the Iris Factory and works by Albert Edelfelt, Ville Vallgren, and other local artists. The Natural History Collection supports exhibitions and research. The photograph archive holds 19th-century daguerreotypes and works by renowned photographers. The Historical Archive preserves maps, drawings, and documents dating back to the 16th century.


