Turku Cathedral, dating back to the 13th century, Turku Castle from the 16th century, and stunning architecture await you. During the tour, you also visit the Castle




Visit to the Fortress of Turku Castle It has stood at the edge of the river Aura since the 1280s. During its history, it has been a defensive bastion, a majestic court, an administrative centre, a prison, a storehouse, and a barracks. Nowadays, the castle is a must-visit tourist attraction in Finland.

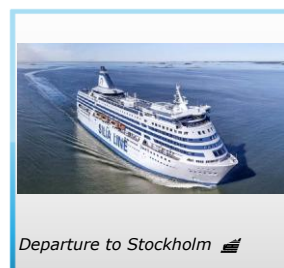

Along the way, you'll see beautifully maintained flower beds, fountains, and quiet corners perfect for soaking in the serene atmosphere of this historic park.

✦ **Tallinn walking sightseeing tour.** Dating back as far as the 13th century, the old section of Tallinn is what keeps most visitors occupied during their stay. The winding, cobbled streets of the medieval capital take you past half-hidden lanes, courtyards, spired churches and old, merchant houses.
