A **visit to the home of Lappish family** and their workshop is the first stop on our cruise. After this, the riverboat will take you to a local **reindeer farm**, where you can learn about Lappish culture and reindeer rearing. **Enjoy a delicious Lappish lunch** and participate in a **ceremonial crossing of the Arctic Circle** during your visit to the farm. In the after- noon, the tour continues by car to the **Santa Claus Village** for a **meeting with Mr. Claus** himself, after which you have a chance to do some shopping before returning to the city.

- Nordic Husky Walk & Campfire Experience. At the husky farm, you'll be welcomed by wagging tails and cheerful barking. Each dog will be introduced by name, with charming stories about their character and habits. Together with your guide and the huskies, you'll set off on a relaxing hike through the pristine forest landscape. The tour concludes with a cozy break by the campfire, where you'll enjoy local snacks, warm drinks, and engaging tales from the heart of the Arctic.

Hotel check-in. Rooms become available from 15:00 to 16:00. You may store your luggage at hotel reception meanwhile. Early check-in based upon availability



Turku Cathedral, dating back to the 13th century, Turku Castle from the 16th century, and stunning architecture await you. During the tour, you also visit the Castle

Visit to the Fortress of Turku Castle It has stood at the edge of the river Aura since the 1280s. During its history, it has been a defensive bastion, a majestic court, an administrative centre, a prison, a storehouse, and a barracks. Nowadays, the castle is a must-visit tourist attraction in Finland.
